

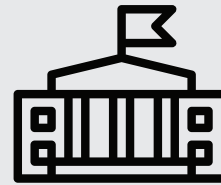
WHAT ARE THE TERMS OF THE POLITICAL AGREEMENT **IN SUDAN?**

The Transitional Military Council (TMC) and the Forces of Freedom and Change (FFC) agreed on the establishment of three transitional bodies: sovereign council, government and legislative council.



SOVEREIGN COUNCIL

- The new transitional civilian-military ruling body will comprise six civilians and five military representatives.
- Five civilians will be from the FFC and one civilian agreed upon by both parties.
- The transitional civilian administration will rule for three years followed by elections.
- A general will head the ruling body during the first 21 months of the transition, followed by a civilian for the remaining 18 months



GOVERNMENT

- The FFC would appoint the prime minister who forms a cabinet from the FFC.
- The minister of defense and interior would be appointed by the military.



LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

- The FFC asked for **67%** of the seats while the rest would belong to other forces.
- **Investigation Committee** formed after the transitional government to investigate the massacre of 3 June and other incidents.
