SYSTEM OF GOVERNMENT

• Government type: Federal Republic:

- The parliament selects the prime minister.
- The parliament also elects the president by a two-third majority to serve a four-year term and eligible for re-election once. He holds a ceremonial position with the predominance given to the parliament and the prime minister.
- The Council of Ministers is proposed by the prime minister, approved by Council of Representatives and serves four-year terms.
- There is an informal consociationalism at work after the US invasion whereby the president is Kurdish, the prime minister is Shia and the speaker of parliament is Sunni.

• Legislative: Unicameralism

- According to the constitution of 2005, the legislative power is vested in the Council of Representatives.
- Members are elected according to proportional representation vote for four-year term and seats are reserved for women and minorities.


